Cafeteria Expansion & Renovation

One of my first memories in the district is a tour that Mr. Pawlik gave me of the high school. I recall stepping into the cafeteria and being surprised at how narrow and crowded it appeared for a high school of this size. Mr. Pawlik told me at that time it had been the subject of renovations for many years. I'm grateful this evening to be able to bring you a viable project with innovative designs that, pending your approval, will become a reality in a few months.

Fine Art Classrooms Renovation

The fine arts classrooms remain the final instructional areas that have not been remodeled in the high school. The art suite consists of 4 total classrooms and all of these spaces show the effects of decades of students. They have been used hard and used well. The proposed renovations include flooring, cabinets, ceilings, lighting, furniture, and instructional equipment, plumbing, and mechanical. The Board has invested in renovating all other academic learning areas, athletic opportunities and programs, and the performing arts. Moving forward with renovations to these classrooms will complete your investment across all disciplines and have a generational impact on opportunities for all students.

Attached to the agenda are the bid tab sheets which identify each of the bidders, amounts, and alternate. My recommendations, in consultation with M/M and Mr. McCaffery, are highlighted in yellow and are the low bidders in each area.

To ensure you have complete information for making a decision, also included is the cost of deducting the fine arts classrooms from this project which I am not recommending. In addition is a comparison on the budget provided by MM and the actual bids received. We talk a lot about transparency and process. My goal is to ensure the board sees the entirety of how we move from proposal, to budget, and to bid to see the process clearly and with confidence.
